## 20 YEARS SINCE ROMANIA'S ACCESSION TO NATO

An example of issues we plan to cover will be this item from Romania marking the two-decade anniversary of Romania's accession to NATO. The admission of the Balkan countries to NATO was perhaps the most significant event marking the end of the so-called Cold War.

These eastern European countries take their obligations seriously. The following is a direct lift from Romfilatelia describing the issue:

This major foreign policy success was the result of a comprehensive reform process. The overwhelming support of public opinion and the political class made the goal of NATO membership a constant concern of successive administrations after the restoration of democracy.

Romania's success was also an essential moment in the consolidation of European stability and security.

As an Ally, Romania increased its contribution to NATO missions and operations, significantly contributing to the fulfillment of the Alliance's fundamental tasks: collective defense and deterrence, crisis prevention and management, and security through cooperation. At the same time, we became an active presence in political debates, with our own ideas and proposals,

Developments in NATO's eastern neighborhood and in the Black Sea area have always, naturally, been a priority issue for Romania. At the same time, we have taken an active role in supporting security and stability in the Western Balkans.

Romania supports the "open doors" policy, as an instrument that expands the space in which democracy and the rule of law are defended by all Allied states.

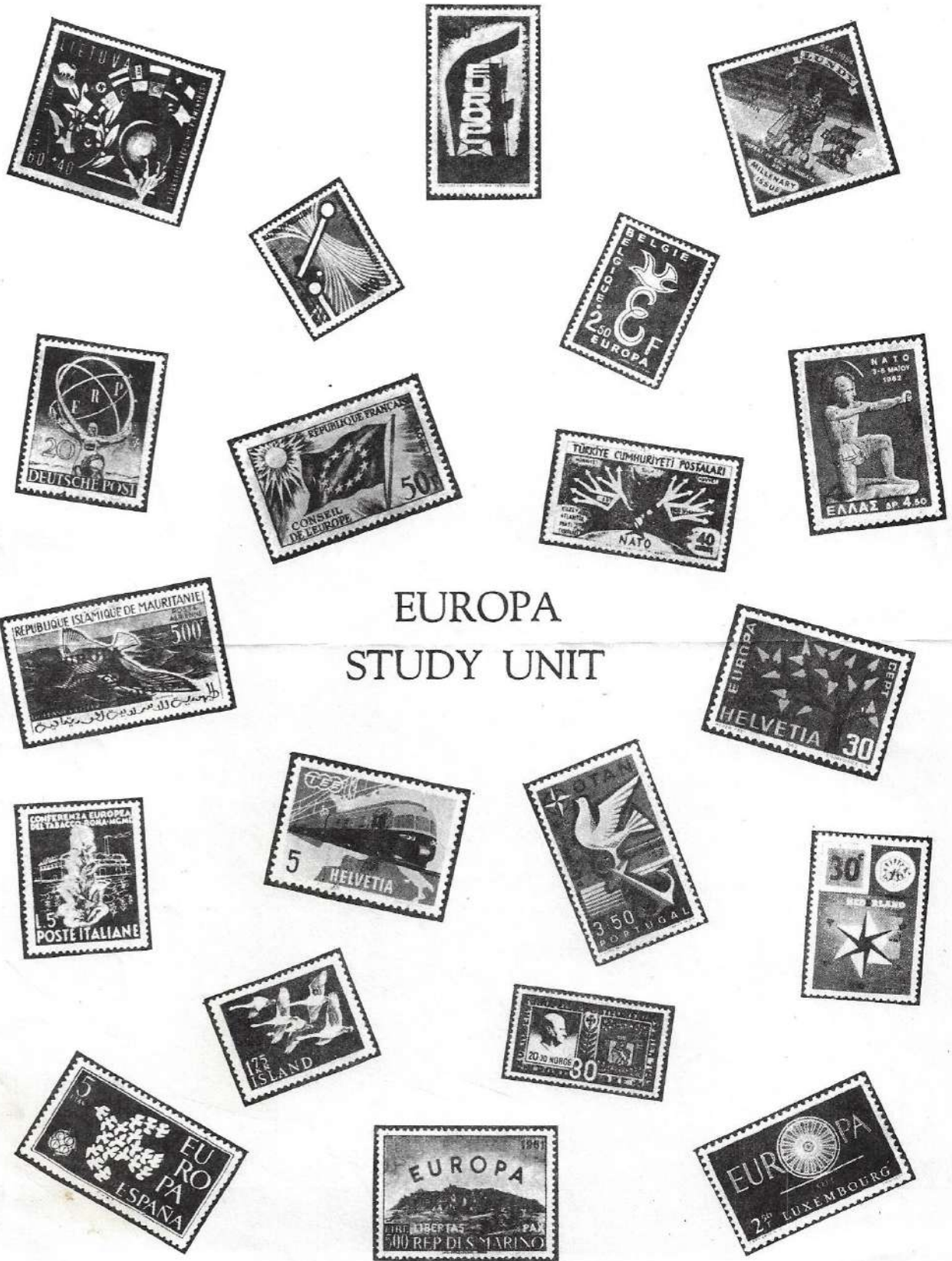
After the Russian Federation launched the war of aggression on Ukraine, Romania assumed an active role in the coherent strengthening of the allied deterrence and defense posture on the Eastern Flank, in the process of articulating a comprehensive response to the unprecedented threats to all Allies. This role was doubled by active and multidimensional support for Ukraine as well as other partners exposed to the negative consequences of the ongoing war.

By joining NATO, Romania obtained the strongest security guarantees in its history, and the 20 years of membership in the Alliance irreversibly transformed it and strengthened its role and capacity to contribute to Euro-Atlantic security and stability.

## "EUROPA PHILATELY — Robin Crowley

The following was written by our Founding CEO Robin Crowley, around 1960.

It requires very little imagination to realize what incredible fun an American stamp collector would have had some 200 years ago, if only postage stamps had then been in general use. Each of the colonies would doubtless have had its own issues, at first portraying King George III. Later these would have been violently barred and overprinted, and all sorts of new issues would have appeared as the United States of America took shape and developed.

In principle, Europa collectors are today in exactly the same situation as this imaginary collector of some 200 years ago. It took almost 200 years for the U.S. to reach its present size. The Europa concept has been operating for some 20 years, but it has made strides which no one would even have thought a practical possibility before the outbreak of World War II. Further, it is becoming more and more apparent that the development of this concept is imperative if the world as we know and want it (and stamp collecting) is to survive.

Europa philately is a relatively new thing and its enthusiasts are relatively few, at least in the U.S., but they are perfectly content and confident that they are indeed in on the ground floor. It is believed that the first Europa exhibit at a national show in the U.S. was in 1958, and it met a cold reception. The judges of the topicals disqualified it because it was not a topic like birds and bees and railroads. The judges of the classicals disqualified it because it contained stamps from several countries. This ridiculous situation was, of course, quickly resolved and Europa is formally regarded as a topic.

When and if a real United States of Europe develops, its philately may become that of a classical country and the present Europa issues may then be regarded as forerunners. But that is the least of our worries and can be left for the future to decide. Meantime Europa collectors have to exercise their imaginations more than in any other topic. We are dealing with the development of a concept and not a visible practical subject. 'Bits of history, geography, politics, international trade and all sorts of other things come into it. In fact, there is by no means - and there need not be - unanimity about What does and does not belong to Europa philately, but its devotees are supremely happy in its pursuit.

Europa, the striving for a United States of Europe, started to become a reality after the end of World War II, but it took us Americans quite some time to appreciate what was happening. Europa philately did indeed creep up on us unawares. In 1959 a dozen of us got together and, in an effort to find out what was really going on, formed the Europa Study Unit. This Unit has never ceased growing. It has no desire whatever to be big for the sake of being big, but it does want the support of everybody interested in Europa philately, in the confident belief that each one can help each other just as did the first dozen charter members.

With its participation in stamp shows throughout the country and its extraordinary monthly bulletin, keeping its members posted on all the Europa news throughout the world, the Europa Study Unit offers a challenge to the discriminating collector and a pleasant surprise to the novice who is looking for something of interest upon which to build a stamp collection. ■
